

Bikelahoma music headliners unveiled

The Bikelahoma festival today announced music headliners for this year's event, planned May 21-23 in Pryor at the FeverFest grounds.

Headlining acts this year will include the Marshall Tucker Band, Jackyl and SteelHeart.

In addition, more than a dozen additional local bands are being "hand-picked" by Universal Records for a special show case at Bikelahoma, the festival's official Web site reports.

More bands will be named in upcoming weeks, confirmed organizers.

In addition, several events are also planned for this year's festival. Plan for the Guinness Book of World Records burnout attempt. Organizers plan to get more than 213 bikes to burnout at one time. Also included this year are stunt shows, bike games, guitar auctions and flat track racing.
